SAN JOSE ANNOUNCED AS HOST CITY FOR eBAY LIVE! 2005

eBay to Celebrate 10th Anniversary and 4th Annual Community Conference in Hometown

SAN JOSE, CALIF. – July 23, 2004 – The San José Convention and Visitors Bureau (SJCVB) today announced that San José will be the host city for the eBay Live! 2005 Community Conference. San José-based eBay, the World's Online Marketplace®, will celebrate eBay Live! in its hometown, in conjunction with the company's 10th anniversary.

eBay worked with the City of San José's Office of Economic Development (OED), Mayor Ron Gonzales and the SJCVB to book the community conference. The SJCVB's local corporate campaign encourages San José-based companies like eBay to support the local economy by holding their meetings or conventions in their hometown.

"We worked very closely with eBay to help make this happen in San José," said Mayor Gonzales. "This is another example of our successful partnerships with local businesses to create great opportunities for our community."

The eBay Live! Community Conference is scheduled for June 23-25, 2005, and will be held at the San José McEnery Convention Center. More than 10,000 eBay users from throughout the United States are expected to attend the annual conference to improve their eBay skills, share their stories and passions with other users, and interact with eBay staff. The conference is estimated to generate close to \$7.8 million in economic impact based on the International Association of Convention and Visitors Bureaus (IACVB) standardized economic impact formula.

"We are looking forward to having eBay Live! in San José," said Jeff Jordan, SVP and GM of eBay North America. "While the eBay community has spread around the world, San José is the birthplace of eBay. We are thrilled that thousands of eBay users will be coming to the heart of Silicon Valley to celebrate eBay's 10th anniversary during eBay Live! 2005."

The SJCVB will support eBay Live! with supplemental marketing and outreach efforts, as well as manage the event's housing and registration.
