


- 180 miles east of San Jose
- 761,000 acres
- Elevation range from 2,127 to 13,114 feet
- Free shuttle bus operates year-round within the park
- Permits required in advance for all overnight stays in the Yosemite Wilderness
- · Permits required in advance to hike to the top of Half Dome

Walk, bike, climb and horseback ride through the majestic California wilderness or take to the snow or the rivers for an outdoor adventure unlike any other.

Half Dome, El Capitan, Tioga Pass, Glacier Point, Mariposa Grove (home to 500 Giant Sequoias), Yosemite Falls, Vernal Falls and Tuolumne Meadows make up just some of the world famous natural attractions available inside the park.
